- Submitted 136 progress reports

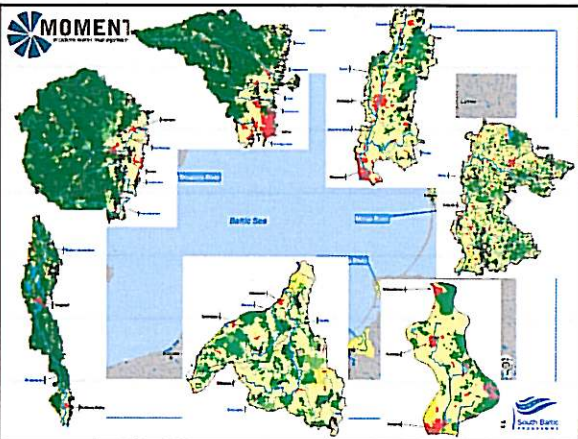




Water Users Partnership (WUP)

- Develop local program of measures
- Working within a specific catchment area







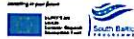
Establishing a WUP

establishing a WUP

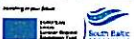




Establishing a WUP

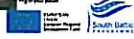
